Proclamation

WHEREAS, following a record-setting 2014 season, the Seattle Seahawks are on their way to a second straight Super Bowl on February 1, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the players and the 12s never lost faith despite being down 16 against the Green Bay Packers in the NFC Championship Game, the team went on to an epic 28-22 overtime win; and

WHEREAS, the Seahawks are the 12th team in NFL history to return to the Super Bowl after winning the year before, a fitting tribute to the 12s; and

WHEREAS, the Seahawks have long been devoted to their community; and their 2014 Super Bowl win brought all of Washington state closer together in support of their team; and

WHEREAS, the Seahawks' defense is the best in the NFL - the Legion of Boom instills fear in even the most prolific NFL offenses - and the team has given up the fewest points in the NFL in three straight seasons; and

WHEREAS, Russell Wilson, the most effective quarterback in the NFL, continues to make history in Seattle as, by-far, the winningest new quarterback in the NFL; and

WHEREAS, the 12s, who have shown team spirit by flying their colors high throughout Washington and around the world, will be out in force in the coming days to ratchet up support as the Seahawks prepare for the big day;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jay Inslee, Governor of the state of Washington, do hereby call for
