SUBJECT: Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Bainbridge Island Police Officer Kurt Enget, 49, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on **Saturday, April 10, 2021.** Officer Enget died in the line of duty on Friday, April 10, 2020.

I have no objection to agencies lowering the flags at the close of business on Friday, April 9, 2021. Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on Saturday, April 10, 2021, or first thing Monday morning, April 12.

Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.

A memorial service will be held at Gateway Fellowship in the city of Poulsbo on Saturday, April 10, 2021.
