SUBJECT: Wedding Ceremonies, Wedding Receptions, and Funerals – Proclamations 20-25, *et seq.*

This memorandum revises all previous requirements concerning the above-listed activities and is effective September 16, 2020. After further consultation with stakeholders, we have developed new **Phase 2 and Phase 3 Wedding Ceremonies, Wedding Receptions, and Funerals** – **COVID-19 Requirements**. These requirements remain in force as long as Gubernatorial Proclamations 20-25, *et seq.*, or any further extension thereof, is in effect or if adopted as rules by a federal, state or local regulatory agency.

This memorandum applies to all wedding ceremonies, wedding receptions, and funerals, both religious and non-religious, and whether held indoors or outdoors. Furthermore, this memorandum stands in the place of any omission from and supersedes any conflicting provision in Proclamations 20-25, *et seq.*, and the Governor's July 28, 2020, memorandum on gatherings, live entertainment, and Safe Start amendments.

The activities described herein may resume immediately if:

- a) The businesses can meet and maintain all requirements, including providing materials, schedules and equipment needed to comply; and
- b) The businesses conduct only those activities that are allowed under their county's phase status.
