

20-07 Proclamation Prohibiting Large Gatherings of Over 250

Effective March 11, 2020, expires March 31 unless extended by subsequent order.

Prohibits: Gatherings of 250 people or more for social, spiritual and recreational activities including, but not limited to, community, civic, public, leisure, faith-based, or sporting events; parades; concerts; festivals; conventions; fundraisers; and similar activities.

The intent is to capture *intentional gatherings of over 250 persons who are coming together to enjoy a common experience*. The Proclamation is not intended to capture general retail experiences (e.g., grocery stores) that are intended to serve an individual experience/purpose.

In all instances of large gatherings that are not captured by the prohibition, we are strongly encouraging that mitigation measures are implemented and enforced (social distancing/6-foot; frequent cleaning of all surfaces; posting of signs; permitting/encouraging teleworking, etc)

***IF THE EVENT/ACTIVITY IS LOCATED IN KING COUNTY**, there are additional restrictions that have been imposed by the County for gatherings of **LESS THAN 250 PERSONS**. See [King County Health Officer's Order](#). Those restrictions prohibit events with fewer than 250 attendees, *unless* event organizers can take steps to minimize risks. The Order provides further guidance on minimizing risks (for example, implementing social distancing measure; screening of employees/volunteers; proper sanitizing).

Concerts	Farmers markets (this is more like a grocery store)
Conventions (including political conventions)	Gyms/Fitness centers (if < 250 at any one time)
Trade Shows	Retail stores, malls (includes grocery stores, drug stores, CostCo, Best Buy)
Exhibitions	Ski resorts
Fundraisers	Routine business meetings held at the place of business.
Faith-based gatherings	Bowling alleys (if < 250 at any one time)
Other similar civic, community, leisure, recreational activities	Non-tribal card game rooms (if < 250 at any one time)
Movie theaters with large capacity (250+) - keep attendance below 250 and can remain operative	Movie theaters (if < 250 at any one time)

Sporting events	Activities on tribal land - tribes are sovereign nations, not subject to the Proclamation
Festivals	Transportation (buses, ferries)
Parades	Airports
Weddings/funerals
