SUBJECT: Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Marine Corporal Joshua E. Barron, 24, of Spokane, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on **Friday, June 5, 2015**. Corporal Barron died on May 17 from injuries sustained while aboard a MV-22B Osprey after it made a hard landing at Marine Corps Base Hawaii.

Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on June 5 or first thing Monday morning, June 8, 2015.

Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.
