DIRECTIVE BY THE GOVERNOR 14-07

- **SUBJECT:** Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Army Cpl. Justin R. Clouse, 22, of Sprague, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on <u>Saturday, June 21, 2014</u>. Cpl. Clouse died on June 9 during a security operation in southern Afghanistan.

I have no objection to agencies lowering the flags at the close of business on Friday, June 20, 2014. Flags should remain at half-staff until the end of the day on June 21 or first thing Monday morning, June 23, 2014.

Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.

Services will be held on Saturday, June 21, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. at the Life Center Foursquare Church, 1202 N. Government Way, Spokane, WA, 99224. Graveside service with Military Honors will follow at Riverside Memorial Park Cemetery.
