SUBJECT: Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Marine Sergeant Dietrich A. Schmieman, 26, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on **Saturday, August 12, 2017.** Sgt. Schmieman was killed in a military plane crash in Mississippi on July 10, 2017.

I have no objection to agencies lowering the flags at the close of business on Friday, August 11, 2017. Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on August 12, 2017, or first thing Monday morning, August 14.

Please notify your staff and all of your field offices and facilities around the state.

Other government entities, citizens and businesses are encouraged to join this recognition.

A Celebration of Life and Military Honors will be held on Saturday, August 12, 2017, at 10:00 am at the Central Church in Richland, Washington.
