**SUBJECT:** Lowering of the Washington State and United States Flags

I am deeply saddened by the death of Chief Warrant Officer Jacob M. Sims, 36, and direct that Washington State and United States flags at all state agency facilities be lowered to half-staff in his memory on **Saturday, November 4, 2017.** CWO Sims died of injuries he sustained in a helicopter crash in eastern Afghanistan on October 27, 2017.

I have no objection to agencies lowering the flags at the close of business on Friday, November 3, 2017. Flags should remain at half-staff until close of business or sunset on November 4, 2017, or first thing Monday morning, November 6.
