# Legislative Direction

- SB 6312 (2014): NEW SECTION. Sec. 8.
- (2) By **January 1, 2020**, the community behavioral health program must be **fully integrated** in a managed care health system that **provides mental health services, chemical dependency services, and medical care services to Medicaid clients.**

# To Accomplish Legislative Goals

- Consolidating DBHR and HCA
  - Certification and Licensing go to DOH
- State Mental Hospitals – analyzed for best and most appropriate administration.
  - Considerations
    - PCG – Community focus of BH system
