Army proposed reduction in personnel, per the Supplemental Programmatic Environmental Assessment (SPEA), for up to 11,000


BACKGROUND

Washington is currently ranked **3rd nationally** in utilization of Department of Defense unemployment compensation (UCX) at **\$39.8M** in FY13

Department of Defense Spending in WA (Payroll and Contracts): **\$13.1B**

Total Department of Defense Contracts Awarded to Washington Businesses: **\$8.0B**

Washington's Share of Total Department of Defense Spending: **2.74%**
